



Recovery Specialist – Opioid Overdose Recovery Program (OORP)

Description: Engage individuals reversed from an opioid overdose or hospital patients experiencing other issues related to substance use and provide non-clinical assistance and recovery supports while maintaining follow-up with these individuals.

Responsibilities: The Recovery Specialist will provide on-call coverage and respond to the Emergency Department to support the patient when an alert is received. The Recovery Specialist will also provide telephone follow-up for 8 weeks to help participants navigate the early stages of seeking assistance and beginning a successful path towards recovery. Recovery Specialists must maintain accurate records and adhere to all data collection protocol.

Requirements: Applicants must have a minimum of 2 years' experience in the guiding principles of recovery and be willing to work toward certification as a NJ Certified Peer Recovery Specialist. Stability of personal recovery, knowledge of the recovery process and strong interpersonal, communication and computer skills are required.

- **Recovery Specialists must have a valid driver's license and independent mode of transportation.**
- **OORP Recovery Specialists must also be approved to volunteer with Atlantic Health System and Saint Clares' Health System.**
- **Compensation is \$75 per shift, additional \$125 for deployment to local hospital.**
